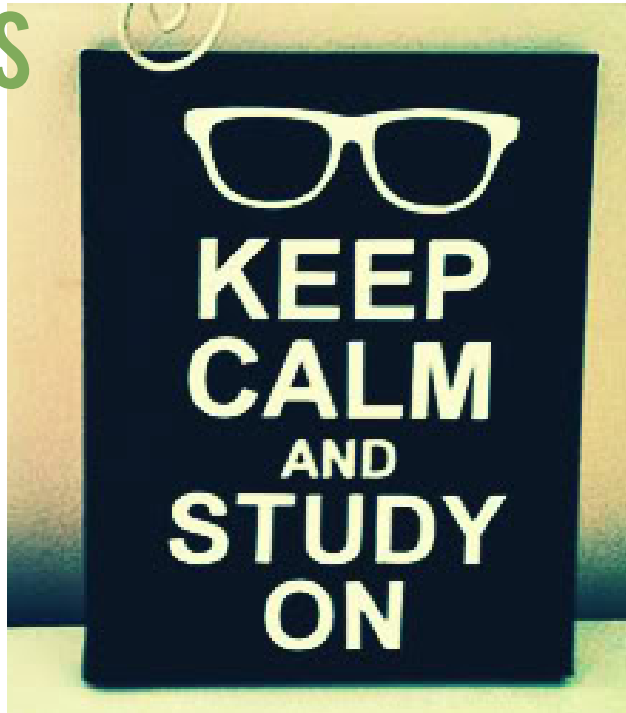

Teachers are using common based assessments as a tool to monitor the effectiveness of our instructional practices and to monitor student progress each six weeks. Students are tested on TEKS taught throughout the six weeks. These assessment questions are rigorous and are designed to help better prepare students for the STAAR test.

If you notice your child's assessment scores are lower than normal, please realize these tests are difficult in nature, but better prepare students for the rigor of STAAR.

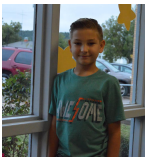
